EXHIBITION ENQUIRY

The West Coast Gallery is situated in Piha, and managed by the West Coast Community Arts Trust. Piha is renowned for its spectacular beaches and superb surf, attracting people from all over the globe, as well as Auckland wide. This gives an opportunity to show work to a wide cross section of the public. We have a regularly changing exhibition program and excellent customer relations.

Thank you for your enquiry regarding an exhibition at the West Coast Gallery. As we receive many requests for exhibitions there is certain process that we would like you to follow.

We are a community non-profit arts trust, and all our contributing artists are West Auckland residents. We offer exhibitions to sole artists, groups, emerging artists, and open themed exhibitions for all West Auckland artists.

We are usually booked up 12 to 18 months in advance.

If you are interested in exhibiting, please submit a proposal to our gallery trustees who meet every 4 – 6 weeks. Tell us about yourself and your ideas for the exhibition, include photos of your work and provide some finished samples.

Exhibition proposals will be considered at the next upcoming trustee meeting. Approval is at the discretion of the trustees.

All work must be original, made solely by the artist, **NEWLY CREATED FOR YOUR EXHIBITION, NOT REVAMPED OLD WORKS**, and for sale. It must be quality work of a good standard and ready for hanging in a safe professional manner.

Exhibition fee: \$300 Summer months
\$250 Winter months
Duration of exhibition: Four weeks

All exhibition fees and duration of exhibitions are managed at the discretion of the Gallery Co-ordinator.

The gallery retains 30% commission (plus gst on this commission) on sales of volunteer artist's work. Community groups will be 30% commission. All open themed group exhibitions for West Auckland artists will also include an entry fee.

Our exhibition space is the back wall of the gallery and plinths are available.
Back wall: 3.8 meters long X 2.4 meters high
Side walls X 2: 900cm wide X 2.4 meters high
